
What am I gonna do?

After being on the SU Team

under various roles for 3 years, and still on the Bar team and a regular face at SU and TL events, I believe that I'd be able to hit the ground running in this role. I have already built many of the relationships I'd need to achieve my goals, as well as having an understanding of TL staffing, and being able to direct enquiries quickly. I've also been privileged to watch and work under 3 different presidents, and intend to carry on their positive changes.

I'd like to focus heavily on student welfare. Access and Accessibility are not at the standard that I believe we can provide. I would like to ensure that all students are facilitated for in the classrooms, whether that be with learning accommodations, or physical access, and also to make sure that gender neutral bathrooms are available on each site. I want to provide more events; both with and without alcohol, including a monthly (at least) resurrection of the bar outside (weather providing), guest workshops, and fundraisers for charities. I believe in promoting student led events, concerts, and performances via the SU social media. I think TL could also benefit heavily from more active and better supported societies, and collaborative relationships with both Greenwich University, and Goldsmiths University.

Another one of my main focuses would be to streamline modes of communication. Weekly updates would transfer to social media, screens in common areas and occasional posters for events. I'd also like to test a few methods of making the Conservatoire's communication more consistent and streamlined to put a stop to the inbox overcrowding. I would create a consistent presence across the various faculties, and online, and intend to have a transparency policy to increase trust in the team, and an open door policy to increase student access to the help and support they need.
